REQUIREMENTS

- All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet whenever mounted on a horse, including Gymkhana. This will be enforced at all shows.
- No Stallions of any age allowed on fairgrounds.
- Any kickers must wear obvious RED ribbon. Must have good quality halter and lead rope.
- Water available, bring your own bucket(s).
- "Muck Bucket Etiquette" at your trailer when arriving with your trailer. No manure dumped on the ground.
- Shavings may be purchased at the Fairgrounds.
- No Parking near show ring at anytime.
- The day of the show Numbers can be picked up at the Show Secretary's booth once entry fees are paid, registration form is completed (including signatures), and proof of a current Coggins and rabies has been presented to the Show Secretary (in accordance with state of NY requirements).
